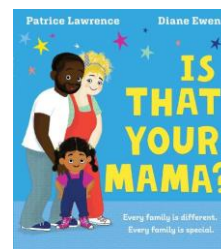
We are very proud that four of our children are through to the next round. Congratulations to Arthur H, Blake D, Ella M and Sam M.
