Year 4 on their geography fieldwork trip to Grinton



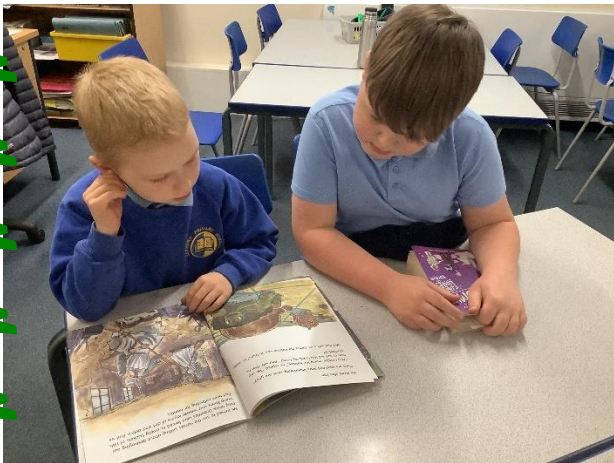
Year 6 in Leyburn, visiting places of worship in RE.
