In Reception and Key Stage 1, teachers are taking part in the Mastering Number programme to build pupils' confidence and fluency with number. In Key Stage 2, the Teaching for Mastery approach is helping pupils develop deeper understanding, reasoning and problem-solving skills.

These projects are supporting our goal to make maths learning engaging and effective for every child.
