Rainforest Afternoon Tea

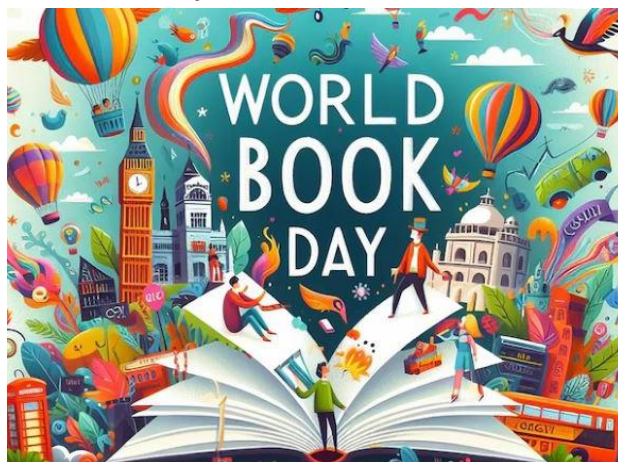


The School Council are arranging a rainforest inspired afternoon tea on the 5th March. There will
