Here they are dancing to Saturday Night Fever!

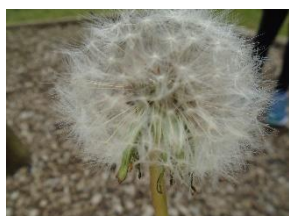
