RE: We will complete our festivals unit and then move onto to explore why people pray. We will study the Hindu and Christian faiths and discuss the significance of prayer.



Science: Our science this term will be learning about forces and magnets We will look at at forces in the concept of pushing and pulling and practically identify magnetic and nonmagnetic materials.



Geography: In Geography this term we will be looking at the geographical properties of the Amazon rainforest.

We will learn it's location, it's features, it's animal inhabitants and



the reasons why it should be protected. Mrs Slay who is from Brazil is going to come and talk to us.
