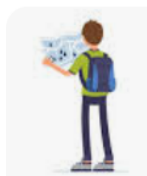
Year: 3 Term: Summer 2 2025

English:

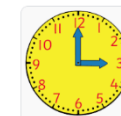
Our focus for this half term is creating a tourist leaflet about Wensleydale. We will use all our local knowledge and look at persuasive writing to inspire visitors to our area.

Storytime / RfP:

We will be reading lots of leaflets about places to visit in the Yorkshire Dales. Please do share any leaflets the children collect when they are out and about.

Maths:

Music:

Our music this term will be learning the songs for our KS2 production. Before long we will all find ourselves humming the tunes most of the time!



History: In History this term we will be looking at the history of farming in the Dales and how the landscape features influenced agriculture. We will support this with a visit to the Dales Countryside Museum for a history of cheesemaking workshop.



Science: Our Science this term will be animals including humans. We will learn about nutrition and learn the function of muscles and bones. We will find out how the skeleton supports, protects and helps the body to move.



DT:

We will be discovering how butter is made before designing our own butter flavour.



PE: * Tuesday & Friday *

PE this term will be fitness and athletics. We are hoping for good weather so we can improve our skills for sports day!



PSHE: We will be thinking about money and work. We will learn that different jobs require different skillsets. We will challenge myths and stereotypes in the world of work and consider what skills we already have.

Computing: This term we will return to programming using Scratch. We will control a sprite in 4 directions before exploring movement in the context of a maze. The children will eventually design and code their own maze tracing program.
